The premises is provide with the most modern equipments of international standard, to be beneficial to the deprived section of the society. Each and every aspect has been attended with minute contemplation, which gives a sensation of totality to this project. The distinct look given to the school premises can be termed as a synonym for symbol of respect to the special children.

Although the construction activities have been completed and the school activities have already started in the new premises, we still require your precious co-operation.

Therefore, we, the members of Chetna Charitable Trust Curchorem, dedicated for the betterment of the differently abled children of the society, wish to place before you, the following facts for your kind consideration and patronage.

Chetna Charitable Trust Curchorem was formed by some of the like-minded members of Sankalp Theatre, an institution dedicated to the Theatre Art, which was established in the year 1998.

Sankalp Theatre has produced many classic dramas



and has procured top most prizes in drama competitions in Goa as well as in Karnataka. Apart from cultural field, Sankalp Theatre has contributed amply in social fields as well, by implementing various programmes such as maintaining male ward in Government Upgraded Health Centre at Curchorem, providing ambulance services, financial assistance to the needy artists and students, felicitating meritorious students and schools, Organising Vanamahotsav in unique way, organising blood donation camps, health camps, organising chess tournaments etc.

Sankalp Theatre organises "All Goa Konkani Drama Festival" from last 20 years. During the concluding ceremony of the festival, Sankalp Theatre organises a special dance sequence of special children in a unique way, which is the main attraction of the function. While interacting with such children, continuously during such functions, we perceived that these children have god gifted talents; and that it is the need of the hour to develop their skills, which can be used for the purpose and their lives can be made fruitful.

AND... We set our aim as "WE WILL NOT CHANGE YOU FOR THE WORLD, BUT WE WILL CHANGE THE WORLD FOR YOU."

In modern days of time parents are busy in their day to day work lives. Some parents have different viewpoints, as such child keeps one household person busy in escorting the child from school to home and vice versa. Few parents also think that having such children will keep them pre-occupied and will have to look after them for rest of life.

We took the initiative and time to explain the parents; and motivated them that facing the challenges of life is more important than remaining in oblivion, as it would only increase the problems and difficulties to such children. We gave them assurance that their child would be safely handled in the school by our professionally trained staff and the parents have a great relief under our roof.

To fulfil our mission, members of Sankalp Theatre established Chetna Charitable Trust in the year 2009. Our target was to provide a spacious and sophisticated school for special children, with the best facilities and equipment of International standard, so that these children get their due respect in the society.

Sankalp Theatre had collected Rs.1.50 lakhs by performing drama shows. We further released Lucky donation coupons to collect and subsequently purchased a piece of land, admeasuring 10,200 sq.mts.

With the vision of incorporating the best facilities, we visited some such schools in neighbouring states, went through many a books on the subject, collected important information from the Internet and decided to construct a sophisticated school and rehabilitation centre.

Along with the construction activities of the school premises, we commenced the school in a rented premises from June, 2015, with a small strength of hardly 32 children; however, as on date we have 141 students, on the roll.



Every child enrolled in our school gets due attention and services they deserve. We collect every child from their door step and drop back. Whenever needed, we collect the children with special care, on wheelchairs.

The children enrolled in Chetna Education Society Curchorem get various facilities, which shape their lives.

Some of the services are enlisted here below:

1. Slow Learners Section

with digital system and can be termed as Smart classes. The special children enrolled in KG I, KGII have the prospect to appear till S.S.C. We can proudly inform that 2 nos. of our students have passed in S.S.C and 2 of the students are ready to appear for the SSC examinations in the ensuing October 2023 examination.

2. Functional academics:

a. **Pre-primary and Primary sections**:

The children enrolled are trained with all the life-skills and other therapies. Their skills are augmented with help of and by developing Fine Motors, Gross motors, communication skills, social skills, occupational skills, functional academics, in-door and out-door recreational activities, behaviour modification, etc.

b. **Care group – Senior**

Although life-skills are similar as above, we

have classified students in Care groups to give them more care they deserve. They receive one to one attention, which is their basic need.

c. **Hearing Impaired:**

Along with all the life-skills and Academic training, the children enrolled here are trained in Indian Sign language for their communication skill development, a sound proof and air-conditioned audio visual auditorium has been equipped with Projector, Laptops, tablets and group hearing aid sets for these children.

3. Autism

The students enrolled here get various therapies along with life skill training. More focus is given on social communication skills, occupational therapy and speech therapy.

4. Care group Junior,

The children with severe to profound cases are enrolled in this group. Most of them cannot even sit and are totally bed ridden. They are facilitated with specially designed chairs, are given primary Physiotherapy, Occupational herapy and speech Therapy along with other skills

5. Pre-vocational:

This is the final stage, wherein the children in age group of 15 to 18 years are trained with all the skills and are made able to stand on their

own feet, so that they get due respect in the society. They are given detailed vocational training so that they can be accommodated in Vocational stream.

6. Vocational

Children in the age group of above 18 are accommodated here, who are fully trained in day to day life skills and can be self-reliant. They perform many vocational activities and make items such as files, paper bags, candles, paper flowers, stocking flowers, craft work, silk thread jewellery, diyas, akashkandils, screen printing. They also perform cooking activities and provide canteen service. They are able to earn as they prepare and supply such items on orders. The cost of raw-materials is recovered and the profit received is shared among the students as per their involvement in activates.

In Door Facilities

1. Toilet-Bathrooms

The school premises are provided with disabled friendly Toilets and bathrooms, with hot and cold water facilities on all the floors.









2. Kitchen

The kitchen in the school is provided with full fledge equipment for baking and cooking professional kitchen items.

3. Gym Facilities

This spacious exercise room is provided with latest Gym equipment.

4. Physiotherapy

This room has been provided with professional level physiotherapy items, wherein the children are given Physiotherapy.

We can proudly claim here that there are ample cases in our school, wherein the children who could not even sit or were bed ridden have been able to walk, on providing authentic physiotherapy.

5. Activity Area Hall

This extensive hall situated on ground floor can accommodate more than 200 students. It is an ideal location for Morning circle time activities, assembly, exercises, yoga, Zumba, skating training, dances, self-defence training etc. All the school indoor functions / programmes are conducted in this spacious activity area Hall.

6. Indoor Play Station (Jungle Gym):

This widespread area is provided with artificial lawn and is installed with swings, seesaws, slides, ladders, whirls, pyramids etc.

7. Mini Market

The children trained with money concept are encouraged to practice the concept so as to make them active in day to day marketing activities. The teacher lends money to the students and instructs to bring certain

commodities. The child has to select the item, weigh it, ascertain the price, pay the amount and receive back the balance amount as per calculation.

8. Fun Zone/Library

The children enjoy and get trained here in music, dancing, drawing etc.

9. Conference Room

This room is meant for conducting meetings.

10. Braille Library

This Library is meant for visually impaired and partially visually impaired students, wherein books in braille script, tactile books (include more) are available. They get academic knowledge in writing and reading in braille script and are trained in communication skills.

11.Speech Therapy

The children having speech problems are provided with speech therapy and modern equipment such as Audiometer etc. are available to improve their speech ability.

12. First Aid Room

The updated first aid items are made available here to meet emergency medical aids.

13.Ramp

The premises is provided with specifically elevated ramp with side bars from Zero level to Top floor so as to enable the smooth walk of disabled person and free movement of wheelchairs.

14. Visually Impaired Friendly Equipment

Right from the entrance to the top floor, the full premises is provided with tactile tiles so as to provide smooth access to the visually

impaired persons. Each and every room as well as important locations are provided with braille signage. An audible floor map is installed at the main entrance.

15.CCTV Surveillance

Each and every corner of the premises as well as the campus is monitored by CCTVs having 24-hour surveillance.

16. Whole of the premises has Ventilation comfort.

17. Health Check-Ups

Periodical voluntary health check-ups are conducted by our well-wisher visiting physicians

18. Visiting Occupational Therapist And Speech Therapist

Well trained and most proficient Occupational and Speech therapist periodically visit our school and examine each and every student. The course of action and treatment prescribed by them is strictly followed which yields excellent results.

Out Door Facilities

1. GROUND

The campus of the school is provided with a spacious ground for sports activities.

2. GARDEN AND LANDSCAPING

The greenery of the garden enriches the aesthetic beauty of the campus.

3. WALKING TRACK, SAND PIT AND SENSORY PATH

The garden area is also provided with a spherical walking track. As also a sand pit and sensory path is provided under canopy.

4. PARKING AREA

A spacious parking area with duly marked parking slots provides comfort to the visitors.

5. HORTICULTURE

The vocational students are trained in horticulture where the students are taught to grow vegetables.

6. COLOURFUL SCHOOL

The premises is provided with attractive colour scheme and the hand painted pictorials add beauty to the school.

Future Plans

1. HOSTEL FACILITY

Chetna is looking forward to provide Hostel facilities for the disabled children which will relieve the tension of the parents.

2. VOCATIONAL CENTRE

In order to enable the students to be self-sufficient Chetna has the plans of opening vocational centre, wherein opportunities will be provided to the students and the products made by the vocational students will be available for sale.

3. ACQUATIC THERAPY AND TODDLER'S POOL

Chetna is looking forward to provide most modern aquatic therapy to the needy students as also to provide a Toddler's which is one of the important therapy.

Concréte Plans

We have Planned for our hostel facilities for orphaned and needy special children.

As the estimate of full project is round Rs. 3,28,38,580.00 we have decided to construct it in 3 phases.

However considering the intense urgency for school of such nature with rehabilitation centre, have completed with the $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ phase (ground floor plus $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ floor) of the proposed building.

1st PHASE DESCRIPTION GROUND FLOOR

The ground floor consist of the following amenities: 7 classes, office block, a lobby, a physiotherapy room, a gym room, toilets and kitchen.

FIRST FLOOR

The first floor consist of the following amenities: 5 classrooms, visually impaired class/Braille library, a lobby, 1 Care Group classroom and 1 speech therapy room/ emergency first aid room (toilets attached), hearing impaired class/audiovisual soundproof room, conference room, toilets.



ACTIVITIES IN SCHOOL DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Due to outbreak of the novel corona virus or COVID-19 all the educational institutions including special schools were shut down and the children were unable to come to school. Parents and the care takers of these special children were anxious about keeping the special children at home and how to take their daily activities and therapies at home. But our special educators, therapist and the helpers took this as a challenge to overcome this barrier. We used all sorts of mode of communication with the parents and the students to communicate with them

whether it is online or offline.

We called the parents in small groups to school by following all the COVID SOP's and created awareness about the covid-19 pandemic. We tried to give them moral support every time. We called the parents to school and trained them how to take the required therapies of their children. Apart from this our therapist and special educators (teachers) are continuously taking virtual session with the parents who have smart cell phones and give home visits at least twice a week to those students who doesn't have online facilities. Teachers started sending worksheets to the students through whatsapp and those who do not have smartphones, their parents were called to school after every fifteen days to collect the worksheets. Though teachers were sending worksheets to the students, they were in continuous communication with the students and the parents through phone calls and home visits. We also started with the virtual classes to our students through 6-meet and zoom.

Students and the parents are motivated continuously to participate in each and every activities that are being conducted in school, whether it is online or offline. Though most of the parents were supportive, few were very negligent towards their kids. We took these parents as a dare and we tried to motivate and encourage them to make their child participate in every activity that is being organised in the school and we are able to gain 95% positive results from them.

Post COVID, parents started insisting us to take offline classes for their kids in school whether for therapies or for academics purpose. By following all the guidelines given by the Government we started taking offline classes for these students by taking consent from the parents along with the virtual classes.

For those students whose parents were unable to come to school due to transportation issues, we had framed home based programme to keep children occupied at home. Our teachers visited few of our students' homes every alternate days to take their therapies so that the children might not face the hitches at home to do their activities of daily living or for mobility
